



A Faith Like Ruths

session two

The Lessons God teaches us through Ruth...

1. We all have a kinsman redeemer. His name is Jesus Christ. {Ruth 2}
2. God's way is for us to admit the need, walk in His ways, and then He will fulfil the need. {Ruth 2:2}
 - When you acknowledge facts about your current situation it does not mean that you have no faith.... it actually means that you do!
 - If we don't admit that there is an issue then God can get no glory for fixing it.
 - We put faith in ourselves and treat God like a magic genie when we believe our words will change our circumstances.
 - This does not mean we shouldn't speak positively. There is a vast difference between speaking positive and bearing false witness.
3. God orchestrates certain things in our life. It is up to us to recognize them. {Ruth 2:3}
4. A woman's life is seasonal, constantly changing but character qualities transcend all circumstances. {Ruth Ruth 2:10-13}

Questions to ponder...

1. Have you recognized Christ as your kinsman redeemer?
2. What needs have you have ignored or tried to speak out of existence? Are you ready to change that to bring glory to God?
3. Now that we've prayed about our goals and asked Christ to help us, in what ways has He told you to work towards them?
4. Do you see the hand of God over your life? Do you recognize His diving orchestration over your circumstances to put you in the position to be used by Him today? In what ways?
