



A Faith Like Ruths

session four

The Lessons God teaches us through Ruth...

1. Salvation does not begin at death. It begins the moment we accept Christ. {Ruth 4}
2. Redemption is a process. {Ruth 4:1-13}
 - Redemption comes through Christ and not through the law of Moses.
 - The law of Moses is only redeeming if we are perfect people and can maintain it.
 - The law points us to Christ through our inability to fulfill it.
 - Jesus fulfilled the law and if we abide in Him then He gives us the strength to choose right from wrong.
 - The fruit of our redemption can lead others to Him.
3. We must sit at His feet to be raised up by Him. {Luke 10:38-39}
4. If we follow Him then it is impossible that He did not prepare the way for us. {John 8:12}

2. What has God whispered to your heart during this study? What one thing does He ask you to relinquish control of to Him?
3. What lesson has God revealed to you through this study?
